

Cronjobs in Windows with Pycron

Sometimes even a Windows user wants to use a UNIX like cron task scheduler. Unfortunately the Windows task scheduler isn't as flexible as the LINUX/UNIX cron tab. Kalab.com has the solution for those frustrated users: A full featured cron task scheduler system for Windows (developed as a Windows service) which accepts the same crontab lines which the LINUX/UNIX cron uses.

A nice graphical editor helps you to create a crontab entry. For example:

0 23 * * 4 "C:\\WINDOWS\\System32\\defrag.exe" c:
```
